





Accessing the Public Dust Control Permit Database


Begin by accessing the **Dust and Miscellaneous Portal**. After reviewing the disclaimer, select **Agree**.




Next, select **Dust Control.** A public record search for existing application information does not require a user registration or login.



Now you will be on the Dust Application Search page. From here, you will be able to search for submitted dust control permits by using the provided search criteria. If you do not know all the information, you can use the % or * sign in front or behind the known information to expand the search. See examples below each search box. Select **Submit** to proceed.



Next, a dust application list will appear. Select the **Dust Application ID** you want to view.



If no data are found, the application was submitted and processed prior to the release of the online dust portal. If you require more information, you may submit a non-commercial public records request on our website Maricopa.gov/5073.
